

2023 Connecticut Watercolor Society Fall Exhibit

Juror - Del Bourree-Bach – A contemporary realist, Bourree-Bach paints many subjects, from the sea, to rural farms and western vistas. Primarily a studio painter, he works in acrylic and transparent watercolor. Del's work is included in the Florence Griswold Museum in Connecticut, the Albrecht Kemper Museum in Missouri, and the Salmagundi Club in New York. He has received over 200 awards including the Robert Sanstrom Prize and Gold Medal from the National Society of Painter in Casein and Acrylic. In 2016 he was awarded Best Acrylic Painting, in the National Oil and Acrylic Painters Best of America and achieved Master Status, an honor shared by only a dozen living artists. Bourree-Bach is a signature member of the American Society of Marine Artists, and the American Artists Professional League-Fellow. He is an elected artist member of the Salmagundi Club, New York, Copley Society of Art, Boston, and Lyme Art Association. Del's work has been featured in *The Artists Magazine, International Artists*-Master Painters of the World-2003, and *Fine Art Connoisseur*. His website is https://del-bourreebach.com.
